I. INTRODUCTION

- The purpose of this kit is to retrofit an existing S-Series lift rollstop with a spring loaded rollstop.
- The original inboard rollstop must be returned to Ricon Corp. Use packing materials from the replacement parts. Be sure R.M.A. number is placed on the outside of the box.

II. TOOLS REQUIRED

7/16" Wrenches

1/2" wrench

3/16" and 5/32" Hex Wrenches

III. DISASSEMBLY PROCEDURE

- REMOVE INBOARD ROLLSTOP FROM PLATFORM:
 - 1. Remove Delrin Guides located on the bottom side corners of the rollstop Figure [1].
 - 2. If your lift is equipped with a Sto-Loc, remove the base Latch Catch located on the bottom of the rollstop **Figure [2]**.
 - 3. Disconnect both cables from both sides of the rollstop Figure [3].
 - 4. Remove the Inboard Rollstop weld assembly from the lift Figure [4].

IV. ASSEMBLY PROCEDURE

- PLACING NEW INBOARD ROLLSTOP ASSEMBLY:
 - 1. Attach original Delrin Guides to the bottom side corners of the rollstop Figure [1].
 - 2. Attach new rollstop to the platform using new bolts and nuts in supplied kit Figure [4].

NOTE: Be sure the hinge is connected to the top side of the platform.

- 3. Reconnect cables to sides of the rollstop Figure [3].
- 4. If your lift is equipped with a Sto-loc, reconnect the Base Latch Catch to the rollstop. Be sure the edge with a cut in corner is facing away and down from the platform **Figure [2]**.
 - a. Fold the lift.
 - b. Be sure the Base Catch Latch drops just behind the base catch. If it does not, adjust the latch in the appropriate direction.
 - c. Unfold and Fold lift. If the Base Latch Catch is not properly adjusted, repeat procedures starting from step 4.b.
